

Materials needed to do Toxic Home Charts:

1. **Fabric Cutting Board** – Buy this from Hancock Fabrics – It has a nice plastic bag that can be used to store the chart in when you are not using it.
2. **3 pieces of Black tag** – Walmart has them at 57 cents a piece. They measure 22” by 28”- If you take them to Kinkos, they have a cutting machine that they let you use for FREE. Cut them in half so they are 11” by 28”. (You need six of them 11 x 28)
3. **2 Packages of Poster-Glo** – 5 sheets of assorted fluorescent colored 11 x 14 sheets. Perhaps you could partner up with three of you and share the extras with each other. You need **six (6) sheets** cut to 11” x 12”. I found these at Michaels.
4. **1 can Spray Adhesive** Scotch 77 – Other adhesives do not stay stuck! I did this project in my garage with the garage door open about 4 ft up – with a fan blowing towards where I am spraying. This has to be done in a well-ventilated area. Do NOT do it in your home. I put down cardboard and covered it with newspaper. Each time I sprayed, I put down new newspaper. You do not want the sticky stuff on the side facing up.
5. Cut out the pages according to the sample sent to you by email.
